Equipment Responsibility Agreement

The Bishop Ireton Rowing Team seeks to equip its Coxswains and Rowers with quality equipment to provide a competitive program in this specific sport.

- Each Rower will be practicing and competing in a shell that costs approximately \$30,000
- Each Coxswain is assigned a cox box, which costs approximately \$850
- Erg machines cost approximately \$900
- The average repair cost on a damaged shell is approximately \$5,000

Shells can be damaged any number of ways (e.g., rack removal and replacement, water entry, river debris, as well as transport to and from the river, etc.). This is very expensive equipment to purchase and maintain. It is therefore incumbent on each Rower to be extremely cautious and careful in handling the equipment. The Rower should listen to and follow the Coaches instructions on the handling of equipment. Should the Rower not exercise due diligence and care in the handling and use of BICA equipment, as determined by the Coaches and/or Board, the Rower can be dismissed from the team (BICA) and the Rower's fees will not be refundable.

By signing this agreement, the parent and Rower acknowledge the level of commitment and responsibility that is required to participate in the Bishop Ireton Rowing Program (Bishop Ireton Crew Association).
